NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE BOARD OF SHASTA COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTER, a private non-profit corporation, of the County of Shasta, State of California, will receive up to and no later than 2:00 P.M. August 5, 2010, sealed bids for the award and contract for the furnishing of all labor, materials, transportation and services required for a new Photovoltaic Panel Structure and Parking Lot Addition for the Shasta Community Health Center. Bids shall be submitted on forms included in the Project Manual. Bids shall be received at the office of Shasta Community Health Center, 1035 Placer Street, Redding, CA 96001, and shall be opened and publicly read aloud at the above-stated time and place.

A mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held on July 22, 2010 at 10:00 A.M. at the Shasta Community Health Center, 1035 Placer Street, Redding, CA 96001.

The contractor shall possess a Class B license at the time bid is opened.

Each bid must conform and be responsive to this invitation and the Contract Documents. A copy is on file and is open to public inspection at the office of Shasta Community Health Center, 1035 Placer Street, Redding, California 96001, and may be obtained upon a deposit of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) per set from the office of the architect, Ronald Beyer Architect, 2515 Park Marina Drive, Suite 205, Redding, California 96001. Maximum of two (2) sets for General Contractors only. This deposit will be refunded in whole if the holder has submitted a bid and if the set delivered is returned in good condition within ten (10) days after the bid opening. Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check or bid bond made in favor of Shasta Community Health Center, Redding, California, executed by the bidder as principal and a satisfactory surety company. All bonds for this project must be issued by an Admitted Surety, an insurance organization authorized by the Insurance Commissioner to transact business of insurance in the State of California during this business year, in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the maximum amount of the bid. The check or bid bond shall be given as guarantee that the bidder shall execute the contract if it be awarded to him in conformity with the Contract Documents and shall provide the surety bond as specified therein within five (5) days after notification of the award of the contract to bidder.

Pursuant to Section 1770 and following of the Labor Code, the Contractor for the work will be required to pay, at least, the general prevailing wage rates as determined by the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations of the State of California. Contractor is solely responsible for verifying all Federal and State Prevailing wages. Copies of the Prevailing Wage Schedules are included in the Contract Documents. The successful bidder shall commence work within ten (10) working days dating from the Notice to Proceed and complete all work within 180 working days; thereafter, liquidated damages in the amount of \$500.00 per calendar day will accrue for each day the work is not substantially complete.

The Contractor and any Subcontractor under him shall comply with the requirements of said sections including applicable portions of all subsequent amendments in the employment of apprentices; however, the Contractor shall have fully responsibility for compliance with said Labor Code sections, for all apprenticeable occupations, regardless of any other contractual or employment relationships alleged to exist.
